Basic Skills Program Overview

Levels

Snow Plow Sam 1—Snow Plow Sam 3

Ages 3-5: Designed to help the preschool aged child develop preliminary coordination and strength to maneuver on the ice

Basic 1—Basic 8

Ages 6—12: The eight levels of the program introduce the fundamental moves: forward skating, backwards skating, stops, edges, crossovers, turns and Mohawks.

Free Skate 1—Free Skate 6

Upon completion of Basic 8: Designed to give skaters a strong foundation on which to build up their skills. This is the point where the skater can choose whether to pursue a recreational or competitive approach to the sport

Adults

Designed for the beginner adult skater. It will promote physical fitness and improve balance and coordination while learning proper skating technique.

Beginner Hockey

Designed to teach the fundamentals of hockey skating. Skaters will learn how to maneuver faster and be more agile on the ice. Proper skating techniques are the Primary focus of the levels.
